ach year the Methodist Churches in Sarawak and Sabah des-∕ignates a certain Sunday as Theological Education Sunday. One of the purposes is to promote the importance of theological education in our churches. Many people assume it is meant for the 'elite such as the pastors and those who are able to comprehend theologies. It is never meant to be the "church education" for everyone. This misconception has led to a lack of enthusiasm in "faith seeking understanding". Many hearsaid "second hand" theological concepts and scriptural opinions become the "norms" for many Christian living. Some Christians often think that relationship with God is thought of as at odd with our knowledge of God, the heart is thought of as the opposite of the mind, devotion as the antithesis of serious study of the Bible, spiritual means mindless, authenticity and genuineness equals thoughtlessness, spontaneity and absence of preparation! Any cursory glance at the Church history will prove to us the misuse and misinterpretation of God's word were able to bring detrimental effects upon the church: slavery, the Crusades, the Inquisition and so on.

And this is why theological education is so important. Our understanding and interpretation of Scripture has a direct, personal effect on the people with whom we serve and minister. In other words, right interpretation of Scripture leads to right belief

ing to shape your heart and mind. In this way, you will constantly experience the renewal of the Holy Spirit in your life through your engagement in theological education. It will help you to face the challenges and the trends of the ever changing world.

Theological Education FOR ALL THE SAINTS

(orthodoxy), and hence right practice (orthopraxis). This is what Paul meant when he entrusted the Gospel to Timothy and encouraged him to teach reliable men and women who were able to teach others. That is how God builds His kingdom. That is how sinners are saved. That is how believers mature and are edified as well as equipped for works of service (Col. 1: 28 - 29, Eph. 2:10). In a broad sense, theological education encompasses all the efforts of your learning of the Scriptures and putting them into practice to live a holy living pleasing to God. In this sense, you are already receiving theological education in your local churches (perhaps you are not even aware of)! Theological education should not stop at a stage where you simply glean theological knowledge. It is more important to learn to humbly and properly recognize what the Bible says and allowing that understand-

Besides giving formal, full time theological training to future pastors, missionaries and musicians, MTS offers part time theological education (we called it Theological Education by Extension, or TEE) to equip all the saints. Thus far there are four different centers in Sibu (main campus), Kuching, Bintulu, and Miri, offering different courses either online, in-person or hybrid. For the first semester of this year, we have a total of 98 students joining us. Come and be part of this vibrant community of learning. You will be equipped to properly recognize what the Bible says and to apply them to your life. I urae vou to consider joining the TEE and be equipped as a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ to fulfil both the Great commission (Matt. 28: 19 – 20) and the Great Commandment (Matt. 22:35 - 40; cf. Ex. 20: 1 - 17, Deut. 5: 6 - 21).
