ust before the MCO, the Board of Management of MTS has been contemplating to demolish all the old buildings in the campus in preparation for new expansion. In the past 28 years of development, MTS has exhausted all the usable space in the Administrative Block which was build in 1998. Due to the implementation of Bahasa Malavsia theological program in 2021 and the possibility of setting up a post-graduate school, we foresee the need for additional physical facilities to cater for the growth. In the last meeting of 2022, the Board gave the green light to build a single storey multipurpose hall and a four-storey block to house a two-storey library, a multi-purpose worship hall, a floor of offices, conference room, rooms for counseling and spiritual direction, as well as space for students to relax and to enhance communal life.

spiritual lessons we could learn from Nehemiah's experience, but two things stand out for the MTS building project.

#1 Despite all odds, Nehemiah prayed and was able to call all to work together. He saw the need and its urgency --- the wall of Jerusalem must be rebuilt. He presented his plan and sought the cooperation of all parties (Neh. 5:16). Nehemiah was courageous and not fearful of the hindrances.

#2 While the project was in progress, Nehemiah continued to lead the people to pledge their loyalty and commitment to God. After all, is this not the ultimate purpose of the building project? (Neh.8:1-6)


For MTS, this project has come

a long way. We are watchful and prayerful. We saw (and still do) the need and shared this vision a few years ago. Now it is time for us to work out the plan carefully and faithfully.




